



## DISCIPLINES

**GT Sprint:** one driver – no categorisation restrictions, FIA GT3 cars.

**GT Sprint Relay:** two drivers – Silver/Bronze categories, FIA GT3 cars.

**Touring Car:** one driver, TCR cars approved by the FIA.

**Formula 4:** one driver, centrally operated KCMG FIA Formula 4 cars.

**Drifting:** one driver, FIA DC1 cars and nationally homologated cars that meet FIA safety requirements.

**Digital:** one competitor, Gran Turismo Sport platform.

**Crosscar Junior:** one driver (age 13-15), single spec cars.

**Crosscar Senior:** one driver, FIA-homologated vehicles.

**Rally2:** crews of two (driver/co-driver), FIA Rally2 specification cars.

**Rally4:** crews of two (driver/co-driver), FIA Rally4 specification cars.

**Rally Historic:** crews of two (driver/co-driver), historic cars from the 1970s and early 1980s with FIA Historical Technical Passport.

**Historic Regularity Rally:** crews of two (driver/co-driver), historic cars no younger than 1990.

**Karting Slalom:** mixed-gender teams of two aged 14-16, single spec arrive and drive e-karts.

**Karting Sprint:** one driver aged 12- 14, FIA OK-Junior arrive and drive karting formula.

**Karting Endurance:** mixed-gender teams of three, single spec arrive and drive karts.
